#### Who or what is Casella?

The Town contracts with Casella, previously known as Pine Tree Waste, for curbside trash and recycling collection.

# Do I have to use the new carts provided by the Town of North Yarmouth?

Yes. The new automated collection system cannot accommodate other bins or carts.

#### Which cart is for trash, and which is for recycling?

The cart with the black lid is for trash. The cart with the blue lid is for recycling.

### Where do I place my carts?

Carts must be placed curbside with wheels toward the house/curb, 3 feet apart from each other or other objects, and 4 feet of clearance above (see diagram in packet).

# Do I still have to purchase and use orange town trash bags?

Yes. Trash will only be collected if it is in North Yarmouth orange trash bags placed inside the cart.

# What should I do with overflow trash or recycling that does not fit in my cart?

Items placed beside the carts will no longer be collected. Please see the Resources panel located in this packet for more info on where to take overflow material.

# When should I start using these carts?

Begin using the new carts immediately on your next regularly scheduled collection day.

# Will my collection day change?

It is possible your collection day will change. Look for information in this packet alerting you to your assigned collection day.

# Place cart at the curb the night before pickup day PROPER CART PLACEMENT

# Put cart on a hard, level surface clear of obstructions such as snow, landscaping, mailboxes, and utility poles. Do not block the sidewalk.

## **WINTER CART INFORMATION**

For safety reasons, Casella only services roads that have been plowed and treated appropriately. If you live on a private road, **please ensure the road is plowed and treated prior to 7:00** AM.

Casella's drivers work long hours to serve hundreds of customers. Please be patient and avoid calling in a missed collection before 3:00 PM. **Winter weather can cause delays**, resulting in the truck being in any given area later than normal.

Keep cart lids closed to prevent water from entering and freezing at the bottom. Store carts indoors or covered if you can.

**Avoid placing your carts in the street when there is a winter storm**. This creates a hazard to vehicles, including the towns plow trucks.

If there is snow on the ground, dig out a spot for your cart where it is typically placed. **Avoid placing your cart on snow piles**. Melting or shifting snow could cause the carts to fall over and spill out their contents. The uneven ground will make it difficult for the truck to set the carts back down.

# A Guide to Your Recycling & Trash Service

#### **COLLECTION INFORMATION:**

- Trash and recycling collection occurs weekly on your scheduled day, either Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday.
- Begin using your carts immediately upon receipt for your next scheduled collection day.
- Residents will no longer have to provide their own bins and instead use the Town provided carts. We will no longer collect any material left outside of the carts. All orange Town trash bags and recycling must be inside of the cart with the lid closed.
